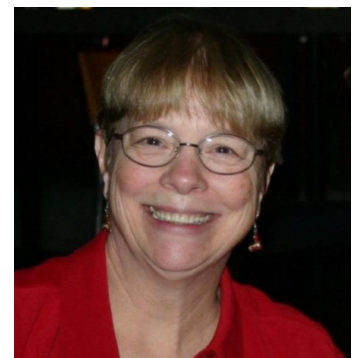

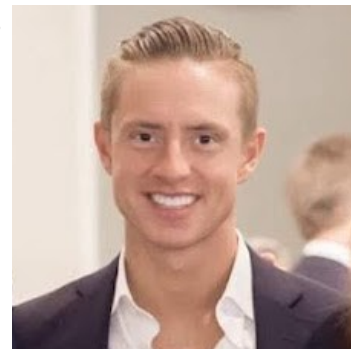


### Missouri Medical Marijuana Initiatives

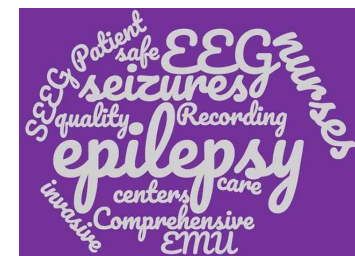
